AHSGE Reading Test will be on Monday, July 16

Students will be tutored and tested on the following standards in Reading:

1. Ability to demonstrate literal understanding of passages taken from textual/functional/recreational reading material
2. Ability to interpret passages taken from textual/functional/recreational reading material.
3. Ability to apply critical analysis strategies and judge texts critically to comprehend passages from textual/functional/recreational reading material.
4. Student will be able to utilize strategies that enhance comprehension of textual/functional/recreational reading material.

AHSGE Language Arts Test will be on Tuesday, July 17

Students will be tutored and tested on the following standards in Language Arts:

1. Ability to recognize correct grammar and usage
2. Ability to demonstrate appropriate word choice
3. Ability to recognize correct sentence structure
4. Ability to use correct capitalization and punctuation
5. Ability to use appropriate organization skills for writing/revising

AHSGE Social Studies Test will be on Wednesday, July 18

Students will be tutored and tested on the following standards in Social Studies:

1. Ability to understand the global influence of pre-colonial/colonial eras of the Western Hemisphere
2. Ability to understand the formation and development of the United States
3. Ability to understand the eras of revolution/expansion/Reform prior to the U.S. Civil War
4. Ability to understand concepts related to the United States Civil War Era
5. Ability to understand concepts and developments of late 19th to early 20th centuries
6. Ability to evaluate the causes of World War I
7. Ability to understand the Great Depression and World War II

AHSGE Science Test will be on Thursday, July 19

Students will be tutored and tested on the following standards in Science:
